Dear Parent,

RE: Year 11 GCSE Study sessions.

As you are aware, GCSEs start in 3 months. Ark All Saints Academy is committed to ensuring that all of our scholars achieve high academic standards. To reach this level, we are offering GCSE study sessions over the holiday periods up until June half term.

There will be two sessions per day, with three subjects running simultaneously.

Session One: 9.00am-11.00am

Break (30 minutes)

Session Two: 11.30am-1.30pm

- Scholars must stay for the entirety of their selected session, but are not required to stay for both session one and two.
- Food will NOT be provided but scholars will be permitted to leave site to purchase their own food. Any food bought in this time must be consumed offsite. No food – hot or cold- will be allowed back onto the premises.
- If a scholar chooses to leave site, they must sign out and be signed back in by 11.30.
- If a scholar wishes to stay on site during the break, they are welcome to bring a packed lunch. The playground and MUGA will be open during this time.
- Sessions are open to all scholars who take that subject unless stated on the timetable that they are invitation only.
- All scholars who wish to take part on any day must be on site and registered by 9.00am for session one and 11.30am for session two at the latest. Scholars that arrive after this time **will not be permitted entry**.
- Although this is a holiday study programme, we still expect all scholars to exhibit exemplary behaviour as they would during term time. If a scholar's behaviour is not acceptable while they are on site, they may be asked to leave and parents will be informed.
- Scholars who haven't been invited to attend revision sessions are welcome to site to complete homework/study booklets and to use the Library.

If you have received a text or phone call from me, please do ensure your child attends each session they have been chosen for.

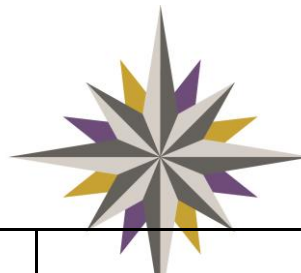
