## **Re: AASA Uniform policy**

### **Hair colour**

After lock down, we have noticed that some hair colours do not conform to our Academy policy.

We want to clarify what the policy is and give our scholars time to rectify it without missing any learning.

- Scholars must have neat and professional hair styles.
- It must be free from cut ins (this includes eyebrows) and hair ornaments.
- We allow scholars to have naturally coloured dyed hair.
- Any scholar can have any naturally coloured dyed hair. For example, black, brown, blond, etc.
- Unnatural colours such as purple, red, green and blue are not allowed.

If you are in any doubt about what is an acceptable change to your child's hair you should contact your child's Pastoral Director BEFORE any change to your child's hair.

If your child comes to school with any hair colour that does not conform to our uniform policy, we will contact you and your child will be sent home to rectify the situation. We do not want your child's hairstyle to distract them from learning.

We know that lockdown was a challenge and trying to get back to normal has been difficult for many. We are therefore giving your child until **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2020** to return their hair to a colour as per academy policy.

Any scholar who arrives at school on **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2020** with unacceptable hair colour will be sent home and excluded until they are able to rectify the matter.

### **Earrings**

Only Female scholars are allowed one plain silver or gold stud in each ear. The stud may be in any part of their ear, but there must only be one.

Bars are not acceptable as they require two studs in the ear.

Piercings in any part of the mouth have never been acceptable.  
Piercings are not allowed on any other part of the face.  
Male scholars are not permitted to have piercings.

If a scholar arrives with piercings which are against the uniform policy, they will be asked to remove them. If they are unable to or refuse, they will be sent home and excluded until they are able to rectify the matter.
