RE: Year 11 Term 5 Evidence Assessments

Starting on **Tuesday 27th April**, there will be assessments in all subjects. These assessments will give all scholars the opportunity to show what they have learnt and what skills they have developed in key stage 4. These **assessments will be used as evidence towards their final centre assessed grades**. It is therefore **essential that scholars attend all assessments**.

Assessment Timetable

There is an assessment timetable below which applies to all the subjects your child does. Assessments for these subjects will take place at the published times.

Preparation for term 5 assessments

As well as the assessment timetable below, scholars have been given **Knowledge Organisers (these are also available on the Academy website)**. KOs cover all of the content scholars have been taught since the start of the academic year. A good way to prepare for these assessments is to use the whole school revision technique "Look-Cover-Write-Check" with the KOs. Scholars have been shown how to do this. Scholars should access all the resources provided by their teachers on Show My Homework and should also make good use of revision resources that can be found online. It is important scholars **only focus on the content that will be assessed**.

Mastery Reports

In a separate email, you will also receive your child's Mastery report. This will show you how your child performed in the learning checks that took place in each of their subjects over term 4. **See template below**. This report will be a good place for you to find opportunities to praise and reward your child in subjects they did well in. It will also be a good place for you to identify which subjects they need to focus their revision on as they prepare for their evidence assessments in term 5.

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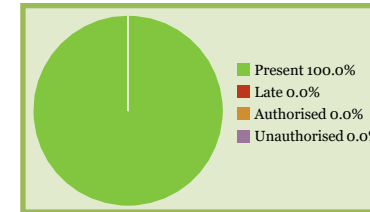
